Who is Eligible?

*All Sophomores may take <u>one</u> Dual Credit course from the following:

Psychology/Dev Psychology **OR** Digital Media/Intro to Presentation Graphics Software

*Qualified Juniors and Seniors may take up to <u>four</u> Dual Credit Courses if they have successfully completed the Dual Credit course(s) taken the previous year with at least a 3.0 GPA. Any student wanting to take more than two and up to four courses will need to get Mr. Stiger's and Mrs. Seabourn's signature/approval.

What determines Eligibility?

*A passing score on the TSI (Texas Success Initiative) Test in the following areas for the following courses:

Pass Reading/Writing Sections: Biology, Psychology, Dev. Psychology, American

History, Government, and English IV

Pass Reading/Writing/Math Sections: College Algebra/Statistics

Pass Reading or Writing Section: Technology Courses

*To be eligible for Senior English 1301 and 1302, students will need to make at least an overall average of 85 in Honors English 3 or a 92 in English 3.
